- Board and Commission Updates
  - Neighborhood Commission Jim Carter
    - Report to N'hd Services & Ed (NSE) Council Cmte postponed until spring, perhaps w/ update on N'hd Engagement Model
  - Parks & Rec Cmsn Larry Ames (D3): special session Thursday, Jan 25, 2024
    - Definition of "Parks" issue: what about golf courses? community centers? trails? recreational facilities (e.g., "Raging Waters")?
    - The city's charter has a definite a three -part definition of what parkland is, which of course means that it's deeded, hat it's been dedicated or opened to the public, and that

it's been developed. Issue: what if piece of property had been left in a natural state?

- >> Discussion: What happens to the underlying land if/when these facilities close?
- >> Action: send letter to P&R Cmsn and/or PRNS?

Consensus of group: Yes, send letter, w/ questions & concerns rather than fixed positions. [Letter<sup>2</sup> to P&R Cmsn sent 1/18/24]

- Advocacy and Community Group updates; other new topics

    - Park Fund Fees? With few property sales, there's little C&C money, and few funds for park maintenance & repair. Funds also pays for Staff: okay for now, but soon?
    - Conservancy for Plaza de Cesar Chavez (w/ Breeze of Innovation?)

### Old business

- Planning for D6 Council candidate forum: in-person at Westminster Presbyterian (1100 Shasta at The Alameda),

Tues, Jan 23, 7-8:30pm (doors open at 6:30): see flyer<sup>3</sup>.

- update from ad-hoc cmte that's handling forum logistics & details.
- We're getting help from Ani & Cat, who were hired by City to help Alameda Business Assoc.
- We've had challenges finding a Moderator. [Issue resolved: moderated by Pat Tietgens, recommended by Cat at ABA.]
- Discussion on translators for the forum: expensive; how to pay? Seek a Beautify-SJ grant? (Not in time for this forum, but maybe for the fall? But the filing deadline is too soon! and can the grant even be used for a "political" purpose like a forum?) Since all questions are collected in advance (no real-time interactions), let plan to handle this by transcript of the video run through Google Translate.
- [It was a successful forum: LLA will give a report at the Feb. D6NLG mtg. (see <u>Video recording</u><sup>4</sup>, and transcript in <u>English</u><sup>5</sup>, <u>Spanish</u><sup>6</sup>, and <u>Vietnamese</u><sup>7</sup>.)]

### Continued:

- updates or follow-up questions on topics from prior meetings?
- Roundtable discussion of issues local to individual communities
  - Jean: in SHPNA, a discussion on SB-330 and the implications of "Builder's Remedy": lot of shock; learning that public's comment has no impact.
  - Ed Saum: there's some protection against Builder's Remedy if property is listed on the historic inventory as a landmark, but it's too late to try to register something once a proposal has been made.
  - This is not being done by the City: they just have to follow new State laws.
